

The Ackerman Scholarship Fund of The Pittsburgh Foundation was created to provide an opportunity for members of the Boys & Girls Club of Western PA, who could not otherwise afford it, to obtain a college education. In order to apply for this scholarship, a student must:

1. Be a current and active member of the Boys & Girls Clubs of W. PA for at least four years.
2. Be a current high school senior.
3. Plan to attend a two or four year accredited college/university or technical school.
4. Demonstrate academic effort by achieving a C+ average or higher and not have any failing grades.
5. Demonstrate a financial need.
6. Demonstrate commitment to and involvement in community service to the satisfaction of the Advisory Committee.
7. Demonstrate commitment to and involvement in the Boys & Girls Clubs to the satisfaction of the Advisory Committee.
8. Complete an application and include a one page essay explaining "How I intend to benefit from my college education".
9. Past recipients may re-apply for the following year only.
10. Be available for an interview.

An Advisory Committee, consisting of the Program and Activities Committee, the President/CEO and the Executive Vice-President of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Western Pennsylvania, will select the scholarship winner (subject to the approval of the Board of Directors of The Pittsburgh Foundation). No member of the Advisory Committee of the Boys & Girls Club, or their immediate family shall be eligible for scholarship assistance during his or her tenure on the Advisory Committee. The Advisory Committee retains the right to withhold scholarship grants in any year if no candidate is determined to be qualified.

The Pittsburgh Foundation shall notify the chosen scholarship recipient(s) of its decision. The scholarship payment will be made after The Pittsburgh Foundation's June Board Meeting and after the selected student notifies the foundation about the school he or she will be attending. All scholarship checks will be made payable to both the student and the university.
